LOCAL INFORMATION:

Parking: Spectators should park in the lot behind the pool by Dragon Stadium and the baseball field. Parking is not allowed in the pool parking lot. Parking is very limited and spectators are highly encouraged to carpool.

Teams with **buses** should drop off their passengers at the front of the pool and park along the road directly behind the pool next to the baseball field. Buses should pull up as far as possible to Lake Creek Dr.

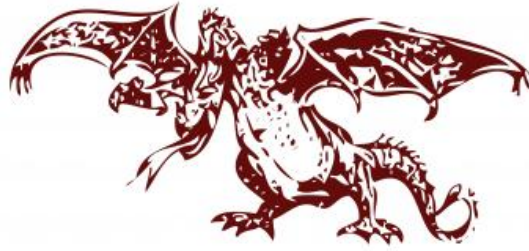

POOLS: Swimming: Eight lane, 25 yard outdoor pool with will be used for warm-up and competition. Four lanes of a separate 20 yard pool will be available for warm-up and warm-down during the meet.

TIME AND DATE: Thursday, 10/23. Meet start at 9:10. Warm-up times will be communicated after entries are received. Teams with the longest travel time will be given the latest warm-up possible

SEEDING: The meet will be timed finals and seeded slowest to fastest.

FINALS AND SCRATCHING: Any swimmer who fails to report to the starting blocks and failed to scratch with the Clerk of Course prior to the scratch deadline (one event prior to their event), shall be banned from further competition.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

Entry Times: Swimmers should enter at their best time. If swimmers have never competed in an event, put NT where a seed time is requested.

Qualifying Times: none

Number of Events: Teams may enter up to **three (3) athletes** into the 200IM and 500 Freestyle events and up to **six (6) athletes** in the remaining events. However, only **four (4) competitors from each team may score**. Each athlete may enter a maximum of four (4) events of which no more than two (2) events may be individual events. If more than four (4) events are shown on the entry form for a given athlete, only the first four (4) will be accepted. Teams may enter only **three (3) relays** within a given relay event.

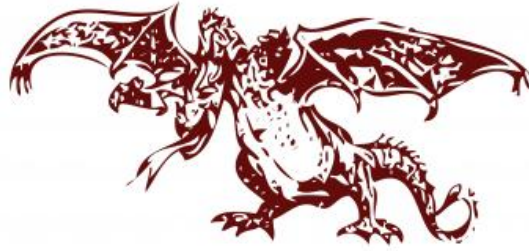
ORDER OF EVENTS: Standard high school event order. No Diving.

Deadline: Hy-Tek Entry File, payment and soft copy pdf of the entries must be submitted to the Meet Director no later than **4:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 16th, 2014**.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries made after the entry deadline will NOT be accepted. No changes to entered times or entered events will be accepted after the entry deadline.

Entries: All teams MUST submit their entries electronically via e-mail, using the Hy-Tek Meet Manager/Team Manager computer software. Include relays and relay-only swimmers with your electronic submission. **Manual entries will not be accepted.**

Fees: \$10.00 per athlete. Make checks payable to **Round Rock HS Swim Boosters**.

RULES AND SANCTIONS: The 2014-2015 National Federation of State High School Associations Swimming and Diving and UIL rules and regulations regarding competition will be applied. This meet will be USA Swimming observed for registered USA swimmers. The coach from each team must submit a list of names and USA-S ID numbers along with their entries.

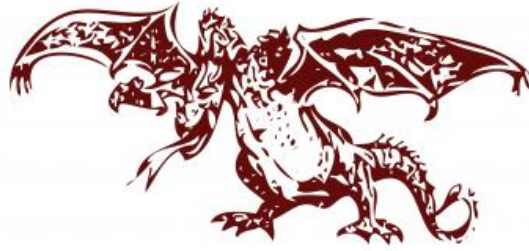

TIMING SYSTEM: A Colorado electronic timing system with a two line electronic scoreboard will be used. Two watches per lane will be used as a back-up.

TIMERS: Each team will be required to furnish **TWO** timers for duration of the meet. Timing assignments will be published in the meet program.

AUDIO/VIDEO RECORDING DEVICES: Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in the area behind the starting blocks, in changing areas, restrooms, showers or locker rooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event.

DECK CHANGING PROHIBITION: Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.



SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES: Coaches and/or swimmers are responsible for notifying the Meet Director of any disability prior to the competition and for providing their own assistant or equipment.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be available starting at 7:30AM

HOSPITALITY: A hospitality room will be available for coaches, officials and meet personnel.

MICKI KREBSBACH POOL RULES:

- NO glass containers, tobacco, or alcoholic beverages are allowed within the pool area.
- Don't hang on the lane lines.
- There will be **NO SHAVING** in the restrooms. All shaving should be completed prior to arrival at the pool.
- Feet first entry only into the pool except for monitored starts during warm-up.
- **Please be neat. Throw your trash in the trash containers.**
- No pets allowed in the pool area

SEATING: Is available for teams on a first come, first served basis. Seating is limited and teams are encouraged to bring their own canopies and folding chairs.
