### WHERE:

Waterloo Swimming, 12332 FM 620 N., Austin, Texas

### WHEN:

Friday, October 5th. Meet start time is 9:00 am. Warm-up times will be announced after entries have been submitted. There will be two 20-minute warm-up sessions starting at 8:00. Each team will be assigned 2-3 lanes depending on the number of teams entered. Warm-up assignments will be based on schools' travel times and size of the team.

### EVENTS:

Meet will be standard high school meet events excluding diving.

### ENTRY FEES AND LIMITS:

- Teams may enter:
  - A max of 2 entries for the 200IM and 500 Free. Only A & B relays for the 400 Free Relay
  - A max of 6 swimmers for all other events
- Individuals may enter:
  - A max of 4 events but not more than 2 individual events
  - Any swimmers over the max entries will not be entered in the meet.
- Entries will be seeded slowest to fastest according to times.
- Entry Fees: (due prior to the start of the meet)
  - If submitting entries using Hy-Tek, the cost is \$10 per swimmer.
  - If submitting entries by hand, the cost is \$20/swimmer & relay entered. Please use the UIL Swimming entry form scan/email to [jackbutler@austin.rr.com](mailto:jackbutler@austin.rr.com) or mail to: 11123 Alhambra Dr., Austin, TX 78759. Mailed entries must be received by the entry due date.
  - Make checks payable to "Anderson High School" with "Swim Team" in the memo line.

### COMPUTER

- **Entries/Roster: Meet entries and roster are due Tuesday, October 2nd, by noon.** Send via e-mail to Jack Butler at [jackbutler@austin.rr.com](mailto:jackbutler@austin.rr.com)
- We will provide the Psych Sheet and warm up information. We will send you final Heat Sheet. The meet will be available on Meet Mobile.
- **Meet changes: Deck entries will not be allowed!** Any changes should be for medical reasons only and should be communicated before the start of the meet. **Relay Changes:** Relay changes must be made prior to start of the meet. In emergency situations, no later than start of the relay.

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### SCORING:

Standard 8 place scoring will be used. Relays are double.

### AWARDS:

- Ribbons for top 1-8 girls and boys in each individual event and for top 1-3 relays
- Team plaque will be awarded to the top team

### SET UP LOCATION

Teams will set up in the parking area behind the pool and are welcome to bring canopies. Seating is limited, so please bring your own chairs. Seating areas are on a first come, first served basis. Please encourage all in attendance to pick up their trash and keep the area tidy during and after the meet.

**Orange and Red drinks are prohibited (Red/Orange Gatorade, Powerade, Big Red, Sunkist, etc).**

### FOOD/BEVERAGE/VENDORS

- Payment options for Concessions: Cash or checks only please.
- Breakfast: Breakfast tacos. Snacks will also be available.
- Drinks: Coffee, water, and Gatorade.
- Vendors: Waterloo Swimming and Jolyn will be set up during the meet.

### PARKING

- Parking is limited, and the lot hits capacity quickly. Families are encouraged to park at Lakeline Mall and carpool. Please abide by any posted restrictions. Towing is enforced. Do not park in the fire lane. Buses may drop off and pick up swimmers at Waterloo Swimming but will need to park and wait at Lakeline Mall. Thanks for your patience and cooperation.

### RESTRICTED AREAS

- Ready bench is for swimmers only.
- **Spectators are not allowed on the pool deck.** Deck space is very limited, so only parent volunteers with a "pool deck job," such as timers, runners, officials, starter and announcer, computers may be on the pool deck during the meet.
- Spectators may watch the meet through the glass in the lobby area. They may also stand outside the building and watch through the windows. These could be open or closed depending on weather.
- Roped off areas on the pool deck must be kept clear for the starter and turn judges. Even volunteers allowed on deck should be mindful of these restricted areas.

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- If there are questions related to times, results, or DQs, please ask parents to communicate with your coach or Booster Club President first. Issues can be resolved between both parties from each team.

## VOLUNTEERS

- **Stroke Judges:** The visiting team can provide stroke judges if available. All stroke judges will meet on deck at 8:30 and should wear a white shirt with khaki shorts, pants, or skirt with white shoes to be visible on deck. Scott Rogillio is our Lead Official. He can be contacted at [scott@rogillio.com](mailto:scott@rogillio.com) prior to the meet if you have questions.
- **Computer:** Please have a designated person communicate all relay changes to the computer team at your earliest convenience and no later than 15 minutes after the relays are completed. Would prefer to have names for relays by at least the night before the meet. Our head computer person is Jack Butler. Please contact Jack at [jackbutler@austin.rr.com](mailto:jackbutler@austin.rr.com) prior to the meet if you have questions.
- **Timers:** The visiting team will provide 1t 2 timers at all times depending on the number of swimmers. They can rotate in and out, but we need 2 for the entire meet. Colorado Dolphin Timing System will be used. We will have manual stopwatches as well for back up.
